Progress

- Functional organisation with Offices in Zambia
- 2 Communal Solar power water irrigation infrastructure sites in operation- Shibuyunji Solar power Water- Women Project & Masopo Project (**Lusaka, Central & Southern Provinces of Zambia**)
- Investment of \$117,217

2022 & 2023

Achievements Milestones

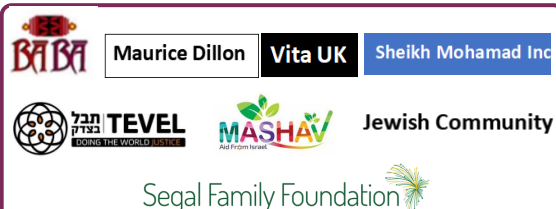
- 4 project sites (Mphande Project)
- 9 solar powered water systems
- 510 women/households food secure with income
- 200 young people on training and producing crops
- 6,000 people with clean drinking water
- 2,500 animals with clean drinking water
- 1,178 peasant farmers trained in smart climate agriculture
- 150 farmers with input loans
- \$150,000 annual combined income from produce

2024 & 2026

Looking Ahead

- 3 more sites, 10 boreholes
- 50 hectares brought under irrigation
- \$250,000 combined annual combined community income
- Another 6,000 people with clean drinking water
- Another 500 households food secure with income
- 1,800 peasant farmer trained
- 100 farmer own small solar powered water systems (adoption)
- Purchase Drilling Rig
- Raise \$250,000 to develop a sustainability farm for AFAW

Goal

Improved livelihoods and rural economy from food security & increased household income in Zambia

2021

Achievements Milestones

- 80 women earn \$100 per month from agricultural activities
- \$96,000 combined annual community income
- 100 Households food secure
- 1,500 people with clean drinking water
- 500 animals with clean drinking water
- 20,000 litres increase in milk production

2024

Achievements Milestones

- Addition
- 3 extra sites resilient solar powered water project
 - 3 solar powered water infrastructure/systems created
 - 8 industrial Boreholes sunk
 - 25 hectares brought under irrigation
 - 150 temporal jobs created
 - 30 permanent jobs created
 - 1,500 people with clean drinking water
 - 600 animals with clean water

- At least \$180,000 combined annual income
